Auditions for adults... something a little bit different!!

Paulerspury Players is planning to present 3 extremely funny short plays staged as if for radio. This is an ideal opportunity for new people to join us and try out their acting skills, and for existing members to try something new... something a bit different.

The actors on stage will be reading from the scripts and the set will be minimal. Recorded and live sound effects will help our 3 chosen plays come to life in the imagination of the audience, but only if the actors can do it all with just sounds – accent, timing, intonation and all the tricks that normally only radio can achieve. Of course the audience will be able to see all that goes on behind the microphones – all that should, plus no doubt some things that shouldn't. Needless to say there are tasks for sound effects creators and operators as well as the actors. The plays themselves are varied in topic and have a variety of very interesting adult roles:

"Cake No Frosting" (Great Moments in History)

Characters: Narrator, Marie Antoinette, The Jailer, The crowd.

A very funny short piece based on the execution of Marie Antoinette although the French Queen may not be quite what you would expect. Experience Marie Antoinette's hilarious, alternative, final conversation on her way to meet with Madame Guillotine.

"Prometheus the God (Father)" by Eric Coble

Characters: Announcer, Secretary, Zeus, Apollo, Prometheus, Epimetheus, Hera – wife of Zeus, Man Woman.

Fans of the film "The God Father" will recognise this short play as a re-telling of the Prometheus Legend and how humans came to populate the earth with an amusing Mafia twist.

"Dirty Business" a comedy by Derek Webb

Josie – a council cleaner, Angela – a council cleaner, Roger – Head of Department at the County Council. There is also a small amount of narration.

When the council threatens to make cleaners Josie and Angela redundant they wonder what they can do to make Department boss Roger change the proposed cut backs, until they discover what 'Dirty Business' he has been up to and they threaten to expose him with hilarious results.

Auditions will take place in the URC chapel, Paulerspury, on Saturday 7th September at 10:00am & Tuesday 10th September at 7:45pm. We hope to start rehearsing the week following the auditions.
