Paulerspury Parochial Church Council wishes to give a HUGE “thank you” to all those who have generously donated to the Church Roof Appeal. So far just over £7,000 has been raised, to which Gift Aid recovery will add a further £1,770.

This has enabled us to replace the stolen lead on the roof ridge with clay tiles in order to make the Church watertight. We are now waiting on planning consent and a Faculty from the Diocese before undertaking the replacement of the stolen copper on the North Aisle Roof.

The Fundraising Appeal remains open as we still have to find some £5,500 to cover all of the costs involved.

If accepted, Stephen Mold will become Northamptonshire Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner.
