Surgery Concerns - an Explanation ... Thank you to all those who responded to the recent Appeal. An application for the new pharmacy on the Towcester Southern Extension site was made in August 2017. The Towcester Medical Practice objected and the application was declined. The Applicant put in an appeal and any comments on the appeal had to be submitted by 11th January. Whilst the Paulerspury Patient Group was not on the consultee list (Govt. Regulations) they provided a letter in support of the Practice objection which was submitted to NHS Resolutions. The Practice doctors had no objection in principal to a new pharmacy coming to Towcester, but did object to it being sited within a mile of Pury End and parts of Paulerspury. This is because under the regulations this would mean that they could not dispense to these patients. If the dispensing list was reduced it would put the viability of the branch surgery under threat, and this was what the practice doctors are worried about. They are proud of the service they are able to provide to the villages and will fight to retain it, and are currently refurbishing the surgery. We will keep you updated.

Village Lighting: following consultation with residents, the P.C. has decided not to install a new street light in Lumber Lane. The PC is, however, looking to improve the street light level between the Barley Mow and the Village Hall.

Adult Fitness Equipment: there has been a suggestion that some adult fitness equipment might be requested for installation in Spinalls Field. This will be an item for discussion at the next Parish Assembly on Thursday 22nd March.
