

PAULERSPURY REMEMBERS

The Village of Paulerspury is marking the one hundred years anniversary of the end of World War 1 over the weekend of 9th to 11th November.

On the evening of the Friday there will be a showing of the recent film; Journey's End, which is an adaptation of R C Sherriff's play of the same name. The film focuses on a group of men in the trenches awaiting the big German Offensive in the Spring of 1918. Village Hall, 8.00 pm. £5 entry at the door
