### f) S/2016/1800/MAF Complaint Towcester Racecourse by GREYT EXPLOITATIONS

Ms Reid, representing Greyt Exploitations, informed the Parish Council that Condition 8 of Planning Application S/2016/1800/MAF had been breached. Condition 8 states that there should be only one race meet per day but two meetings per operational day have been held since 5 November 2016

Ms Reid brought it to the attention of the Parish Council that despite Condition 2 stating that: No public address system shall be used on site prior to 10:30 am or after 11:30 pm a Greyhound Derby was planned to take place on 1 July 2017 with a disco commencing at 10:45pm. A timetable for the departure of coaches (8 x 80 seaters) showed that the last coach would leave at 1:00am on 2 July 2017 in contravention of the permitted operational time of 11:30 pm.

Conditions 2 and 8 were set to protect the amenities of the nearby residents and to comply with Policy G3 of the South Northamptonshire Local Plan.

The Clerk would seek the advice of the Enforcement Officer at SNC regarding these breaches.
