The Parish Council is delighted to announce that it has been awarded two substantial amounts of money for the new leisure equipment to be installed on Spinalls Field. The project has been divided into two phases the first, as a result of £16,999 from the New Homes Bonus Scheme, will be the installation of a climbing frame for 2-8 year olds, a multi-game goal area for youngsters and two picnic tables; all of which are due for completion in May.

We came second in the Tesco 'Bag for Life' scheme voting and have been awarded a further £10,000 for which a shelter and a zip wire are under consideration. There will be further consultation on these items once the money has been secured.
