#### Neighbourhood Watch alert - ATM SCAM.

On Saturday the 7<sup>th</sup> of June 2014 at 11:20 hours victim was at cash point outside bank, Barclays Bank, Watling Street, Towcester when suspect was stood directly behind victim. Suspect distracted victim by telling him "Your ticket hasn't come out". The suspect at this point had removed the victim's card and, when challenged by victim on noticing his card was missing from the machine, made good his escape. Suspect described as a Asian Male aged 20-30 years 5.2 in height, slim build, smart clothing with short dark hair.

A reminder for people to be vigilant when using ATM machines, if possible use the machine inside the bank. Do not write your pin number down, always shield your pin number when using cash machines. Avoid unnecessary distractions, do not turn around and speak to anyone until YOU have removed and secured your bank card ending your transaction. Neighbourhood Watch.
