Just over one year ago we were visited by Ofsted who graded us a "GOOD" school. Achievement of Pupils, Quality of Teaching, and Leadership and Management were all Good, with Behaviour of Pupils bordering on Outstanding. This year we have concentrated on consolidating this, providing us with the foundations to strive for Outstanding status. Despite these results, a current focus of our work is the number of children we educate. We currently have 114 children on roll and a predicted 117 on roll in September.
