#### **Defibrillators**

Paulerspury Parish Council has purchased two Defibrillators, one of which will be installed on the outside wall of the school and the other will be located in the telephone box in Lower Street, Pury End. The one on the school will have one pair of adult electrodes and one pair of child's electrodes.

All residences in the Parish will be receiving a leaflet which will inform residents about these appliances. There will also be an instruction evening on 12 October 2016 in Paulerspury Village Hall at 7.30 pm when East Midlands Ambulance Service will explain these appliances in more detail and demonstrate their use.
