A thank you on behalf of the Village Hall Committee to the Paulerspury Pre-School helpers and parents who helped to clear up after a senseless act of vandalism was discovered on Friday morning 4th of May.

Somehow, a person or persons unknown had gained entrance to the hall, probably at the end of Thursday's Pre-School session, had inserted the plugs into all three wash basins in the men's toilet, and turned the taps on. As a result, the toilet, the entrance hall, the kitchen and part of the main hall were awash with an inch or two of water! The helpers and some parents set-to, mopping and clearing the affected areas and the pre-school was up and running in the main hall without too much delay. Again, thanks to all who helped.

The plugs for the sinks in the men's toilet have now been removed and security measures at the end of the Pre-School session have been tightened.
