NEW; NEIGHBOURHOOD ALERT SYSTEM The Neighbourhood Alert system is an online, secure community messaging system that allows authorised administrators (such as your local police force) to log in and send messages to registered people in the community, who have chosen to receive them. It is a particularly useful tool for our local police force allowing them to send crime alerts, advice on keeping safe, alerts on computer crime, scams and much more. Once enrolled, users can use the settings to tailor how much and what sort of information they want to receive. Enrolment is quick and easy.
