NEW BUS SERVICE FOR PAULERSPURY

Fantastic News for Paulerspury residents, after months of no public transport in the village of Paulerspury, a local social enterprise has come up with a solution to help the residents.

ABILITY Community Transport have, over a period of months, been working with the members of the Parish Council and residents to bring back a bus service to the village.

The solution is to commence a weekly service to allow people to get to Towcester for shopping, health or leisure purposes. It will collect passengers from agreed locations in the village and will allow a couple of hours in Towcester (dropping off at Bell Plantation, TESCO/ALDI, Waitrose, and the town centre) before returning.

How the Service works!.....Community Transport operates slightly differently to a normal bus service - to use the service, each person will be required to register for the service and pre book your seat.

The service will run on **Wednesday** morning into Towcester allowing 2 to 2.5 hours shopping, drop off and pick up points will be Bell Plantation, Tesco, Waitrose and the Market Square.

Passengers will need to be registered before travelling and seats need to be booked 24hrs in advance of travel.
