Many positive actions have begun life at an Annual Parish Assembly. There are serious challenges ahead for our small parish so your views are of great value to the Parish Council. ELECTIONS.

Parish Council Elections will take place on Thursday 7 May 2020. Nomination papers are available from South Northamptonshire Council, The Forum, Moat Lane Towcester. Nominations can be delivered anytime weekdays between 10am and 4pm from 27 March to 8 April at the Forum. Statutory deadline is **4pm on 8 April.** Nomination papers can be handed in by someone other than the candidate. An appointment is necessary for an informal check 27 March-8 April 10am–4pm.

A candidate briefing will be held at The Forum on Thursday 12 March at 6:30pm. Below is a link to the Electoral Commission's guidance for candidates standing at Parish Councils in England Please note, however, that the register you will need for elector numbers will be the March register.
