### 103/10/20 **PLANNING MATTERS**

# a) <u>S/2020/1505/MAF Manor Farm Green Energy. Manor Farm, Grafton Road, Alderton</u>

Variation of conditions 1 (plans) and 18 (feeding regime) of S/2016/1727/MAF to increase throughput, allow additional feedstock to come from other farms and to modify the surface water and digestate lagoon design to an open lagoon.

Paulerspury Parish Council objected to Application S/2020/1505/MAF on the following grounds:

The original plan stated that there would be no need to increase the size of the clamps which hold the biomaterial. Paulerspury Parish Council had concerns that, having underestimated their requirements in the past by some 16,000 tons, these new projections may not be reliable as being final long term.

Vehicles were currently passing through Alderton village despite regulations and

agreements demanding otherwise. This was detrimental to the residents of Alderton.

## b) S/2020/1593/FUL Mr A Dennis 21 Stony Hill, Paulerspury

Two storey rear extension.

Paulerspury Parish Council had no objections to this application.
