18/02/23 **APOLOGIES**

Apologies were received from Mrs Gee and Mr Barker. These were accepted by the council.

22/02/23 MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC AND PRESS

Comments are welcome from those attending the meeting. The total time allowed for this item is 15 minutes with a maximum of 3 minutes per speaker. Further public comment during the meeting is permissible only at the invitation of the Chairman.

Two members of the public were present including County Councillor Mr Ken Pritchard, Mr Barter having sent his apologies for his absence.

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Mr Pritchard outlined various financial and planning items.

<u>WNC Budget 2023/4</u> The draft budget for 2023/2024 had risen by 4.99% which included 2% for the Social Care element. Police (£15 per annum) and Fire costs (£5) still to be added to the final individual Council Tax figure. This would give a figure of £1694 for a band D property = an increase of £1.55 per week. Council house rents would rise by 7%. For the year end of 2023 WNC was forecasting an overspend of £3/£4m.

The charge for Green waste bins would rise to £55 per annum with Black bin collections possibly moving to a three week cycle.

<u>A43 Link Road Roundabout</u>. Problems had arisen regarding the planning of this proposed roundabout. Opening time pushed back to 2025. The A5 Link Road roundabout is scheduled to be open by July 2023.

<u>Towcester town traffic management</u> Various options were being considered in order to limit the volume of heavy traffic through the town.

<u>Integrated Care Strategy (ICS)</u> The ICS would replace the Clinical Care Group bringing all services under one umbrella organisation.

<u>Towcester South Community Centre.</u> This was scheduled to open in 2024.
