Finally the meeting on December 5th is of course our Xmas lunch but with the threatened closure of the Barley Mow we are looking at alternatives and would welcome any suggestions.


Of course all our meetings include tea, sandwiches and cake and plenty of friendly chat. See you all on 5th Sept. Any questions as usual to Jan on 811771.
